<p>3.0 BUSINESS</p> <p>3.1 Worship, Witness, Parish Life</p>	<p>a. Parish Visitors Strategy. Terms of Reference were distributed to the parish on Sun 19 Jul. Brad provided an update on timings, training, and the screening process. We have 6 visitors for the fall with one more coming on later. Brian Branchaud has agreed to the Parish Screening in Faith Coordinator.</p> <p>b. Music Advisory Committee: An option was distributed with five options. Most people agreed that we need an organist, although there was discussion about whether the organist should be full-time (i.e. every week) or part-time. Feedback on the current music programme was positive: people appreciate some of the experiments we've tried (e.g. the drum).
